




Katzecure post-installation tips


Now that your system is installed, we would like to give you some useful tips and considerations to ensure that you get a long service life out of your system.

Early Days

During system installation, the Katzecure team will have identified and remedied any potential gaps or areas of weakness in your garden. The system should be totally effective from Day One. However, cats are intelligent and unpredictable and each garden is unique. During the early days we recommend that you:

- Watch your cat's behaviour in the newly secured garden in case they identify any unforeseen weakness in the system.
- Be vigilant for any intruders, (possibly a neighbouring habitual visitor), who enters the garden and cannot then escape. It is possible that due to high adrenalin levels the intruder may be able to escape. In the event of this, the escape route is an area of weakness that we will be able to address.

The Katzecure installation team work hard to ensure that the system is fully functioning upon departure. While your cats adapt to their newly found freedom, extra vigilance is recommended. In the event of a concern, please do not hesitate to contact us so that we can advise you and if necessary book a visit to rectify any problems.



Care of the System

Katzecure only uses the highest quality natural wood sourced from British Forestry Commission sustainable wood farms. The system is designed to blend in with your garden environment as well as providing maximum security for your cat. As the system will be exposed to all weather conditions, we have included some tips and reminders on how to care for your newly installed Katzecure product.

- **Colour:** As the wood is natural, the grain or wood shade can be slightly different between poles. The wood is tanalised to improve the timber's outdoor durability. Although not necessary, the system can be painted any colour to fit in with your garden scheme. The same outdoor wood paint or stain that you would apply to your fencing structure can be used on the Katzecure poles.
- **Splitting:** Splits in the wooden poles can occur as they dry out, which is perfectly normal. Whilst the timber is wet, its splitting tendency will be reduced, as the poles swell, closing the gaps. Split wood does not impair the performance of the axles.
- **Resin:** In some types of wood, a sappy discharge may occur, but this is a natural process.

The system does not require much maintenance, but we do recommend that you periodically check that the poles are still spinning, especially after weather conditions such as storms, snow and ice or heat waves. If a pole becomes stiff, then please call us. Lubricant such as WD40 can be applied to the end grain of the wood to provide protection and reduce moisture ingress.

Safety

The system is designed to spin on contact and deter your treasured cat from escaping from your garden. It is not a toy. Children should be discouraged from reaching to spin the poles, throwing things at it, climbing over it or generally mishandling the system. Although robustly installed, mistreating the system may impair its performance and cause a hazard.

Notice Sign

The system is installed on your side of the garden perimeter. If requested, we include a notice that can be positioned in a convenient location to alert people of the presence of the Katzecure system (this is similar to a sign that alerts the presence of a guard dog).
